Note: Specific degree/major requirements may vary; applicants should check individual programme requirements for details.

## Admission Arrangements

**Year 1 Admission:** Applicants with a school-leaving qualification or a partially completed sub-degree can apply for Year 1 of a Bachelor's degree. Depending on the programme, students may enter directly into a major or start with an undeclared major, choosing a specialization after one year.

### Advanced Standing Admissions:

- **Advanced Standing I:** Students admitted under this category must complete a minimum of 91 credit units for graduation instead of the standard 121, depending on their major.
- **Advanced Standing II (Senior Year):** Senior entrants must complete at least 60 credit units for graduation.

Students with Advanced Standing are not eligible for further credit transfers based on prior qualifications but may receive exemptions from specific courses without earning credit.

**Additional Notes:** AD/HD graduates not qualifying for Advanced Standing II may be considered for Advanced Standing I. Applicants do not need to indicate their preference for Advanced Standing at the time of application, as the decision is made by the programme unit. For programmes without Advanced Standing II options, applicants are encouraged to apply for Advanced Standing I if available.
