Requirements for the Axel Adler Scholarship 2026

The University of Gothenburg offers the **Axel Adler Scholarship 2026**. To be eligible for the **Axel Adler Scholarship**:

- You are required to pay tuition fees in Sweden.
- You need to apply for an international campus-based programme at the University of Gothenburg, as your first priority.
- You have applied and been admitted to a full-time Master's programme at the University of Gothenburg, or you have applied and been admitted to one of the following full-time Bachelor's programmes at the University of Gothenburg: Software Engineering, International Relations, Business and Economics, BFA Programme in Metal Art, BFA Programme in Wood Oriented Furniture Design and BFA Programme in Craft with Specialisation in Crafting Futures.
- You can only be eligible for the scholarship for the programme that is your first priority at the University of Gothenburg on the **15th of January 2026** in the international admission round at www.universityadmission.se.
- You have submitted your application for studies by **15 January 2026** and paid the application fee as well as documented your eligibility for studies by **2 February 2026** through universityadmissions.se.
- You received an email with an invitation to apply for the scholarship and applied for the scholarship between **10 - 28 February 2026**.

Conditions for the Axel Adler Scholarship 2026

- The Axel Adler Scholarship covers the tuition fee for the whole programme to which a student has have been admitted. This means 4 semesters/120 credits for Master's programmes (except for 1-year Master programmes such as Investigative Journalism which is 2 semesters/60 credits) and 6 semesters/180 credits for Bachelor's programmes. **The Axel Adler Scholarship does not cover living or accommodation expenses.**
- Scholarship holders are covered by FAS+, which is an insurance issued under the authority of the Swedish Legal, Financial and Administrative Service Agency (Kammarkollegiet). You will find the terms and conditions for the FAS+ insurance on the website of Kammarkollegiet.
- To keep your scholarship, you must complete at least 75% of the semester's credits. Regular follow-ups are conducted regularly.
- The scholarship will be revoked if you do not start in time or do not continue your studies at the University of Gothenburg in accordance with the rules and regulations for studies at the University of Gothenburg.

If you are suspended from your studies, your scholarship can be withdrawn.

- If you are awarded the scholarship, it is important to apply for a residence permit for studies from the Swedish Migration Agency as soon as possible. In order to be granted a residence permit for studies, you must show that you have the financial means to support yourself. - The scholarship is only valid if you receive a residence permit for studies from the Swedish Migration Agency in time to start your programme.
